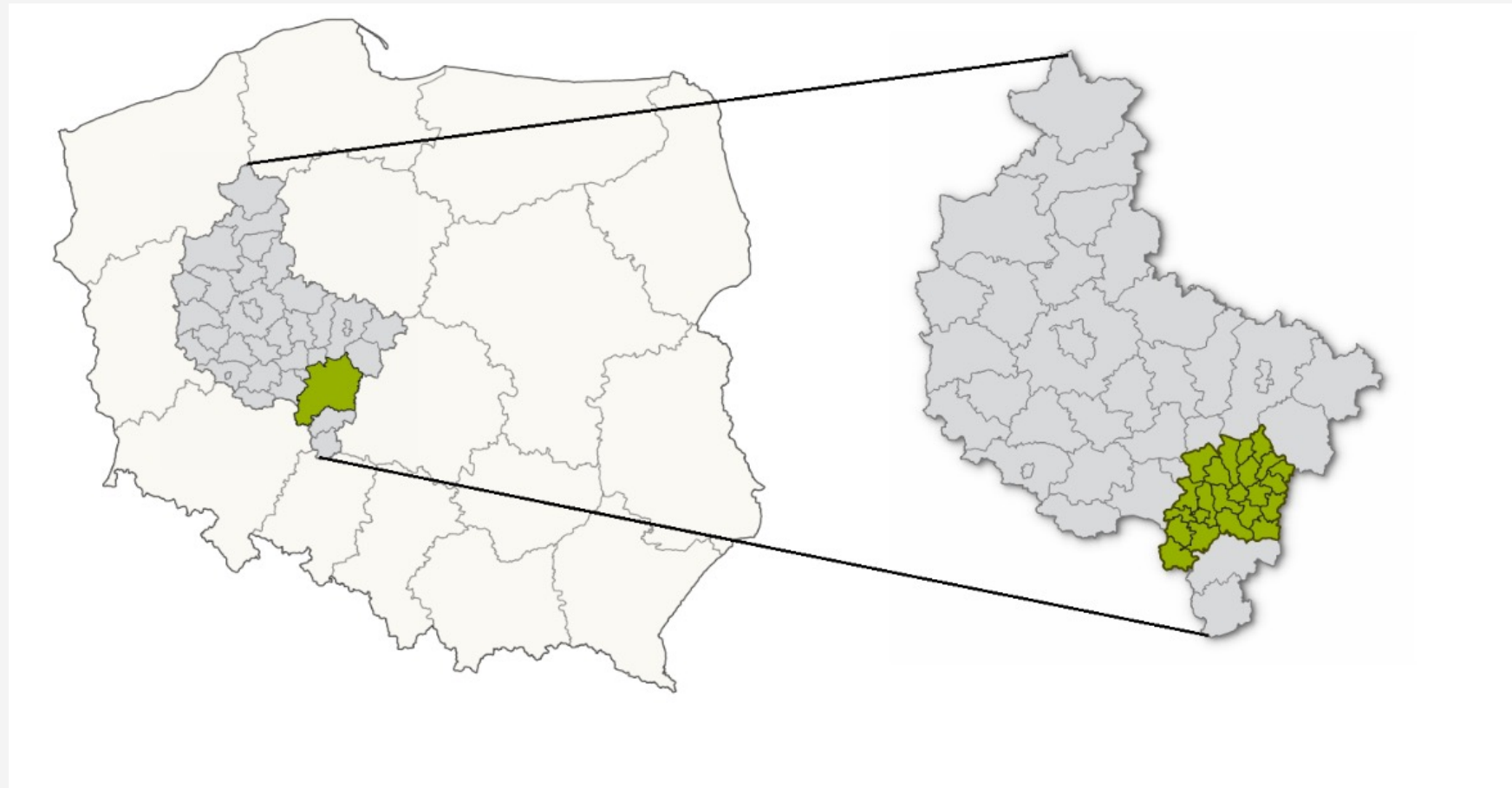

25 local government units:

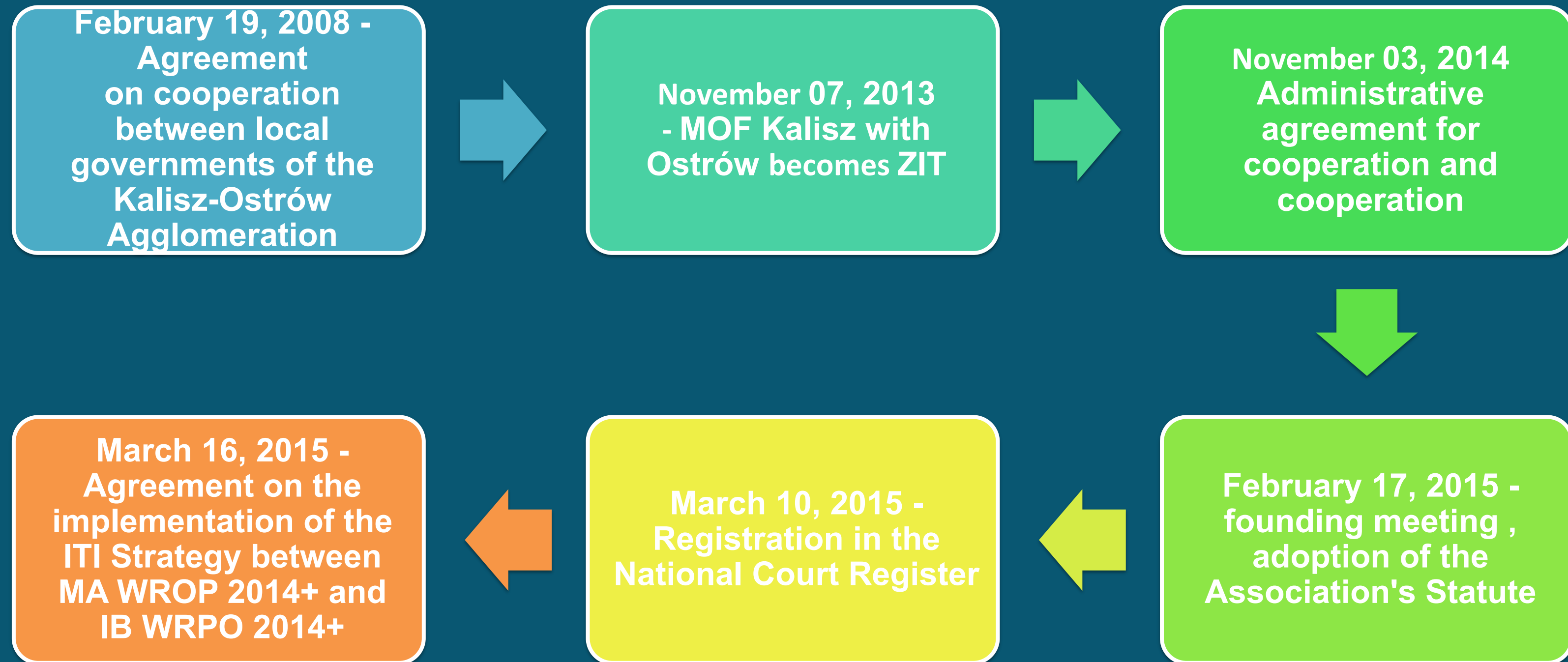

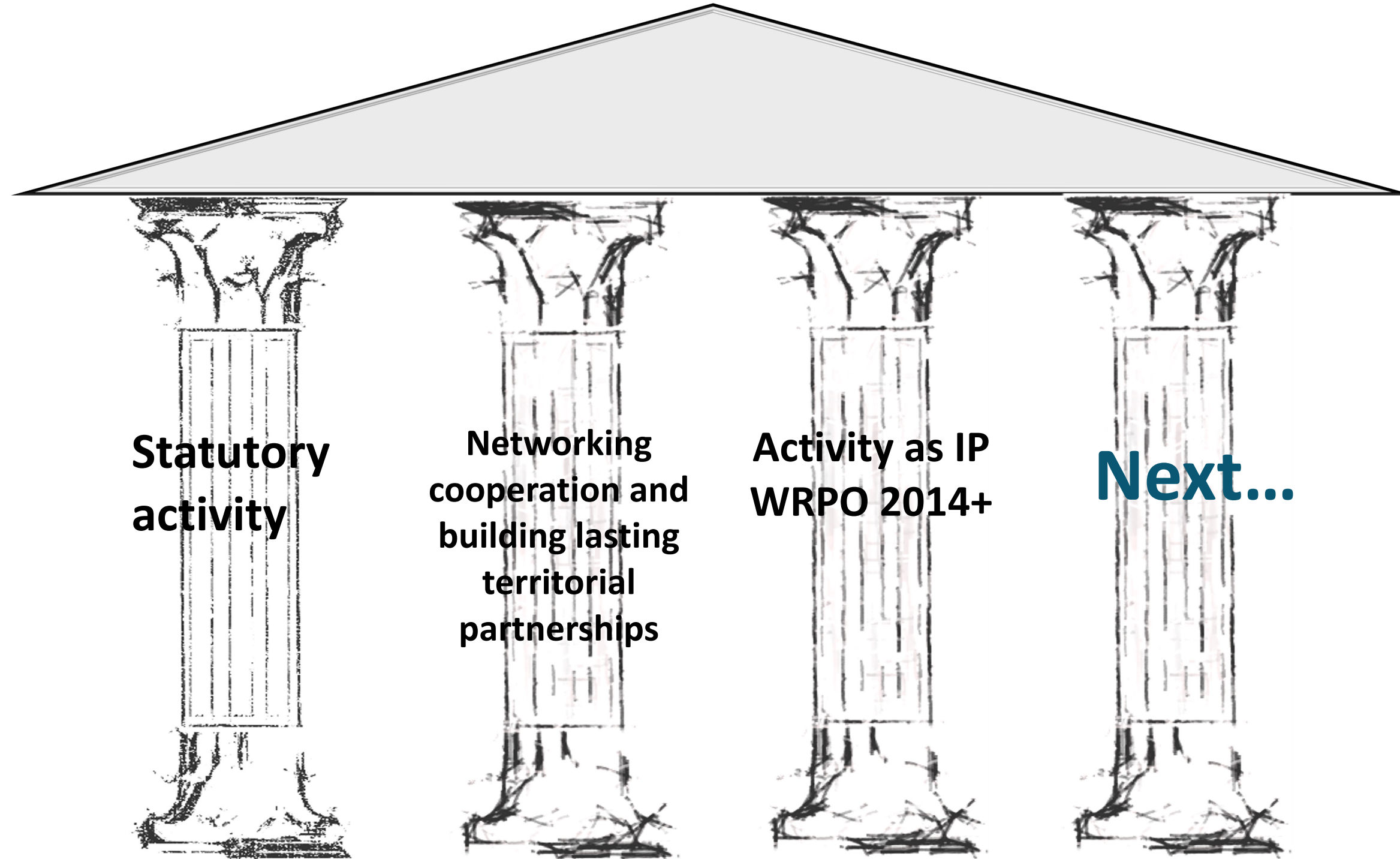

Social participation – why do we use it?

- Residents know and understand the intentions of local authorities - at the same time legitimizing their actions;
- Local needs are better diagnosed;
- Lively responding to emerging problems and efficient communication;
- Residents are both involved in the process of coming up with a solution/strategy as well as being part of the solution;
- Increased trust in local authorities - effective communication;
- Real and potential local resources are used to solve problems - extensive use of various competences, skills of people and institutions;
- Residents are not passive recipients of services, but active subjects of change;
- A culture of dialogue and creativity is being created;
- Potential conflicts in the future are prevented, especially in sensitive matters.

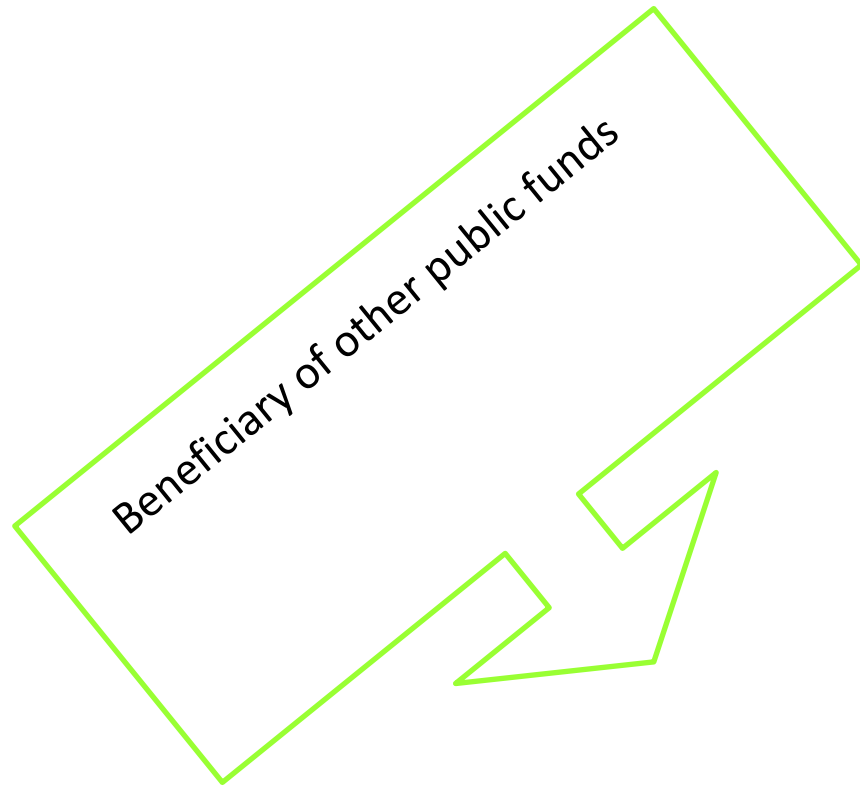

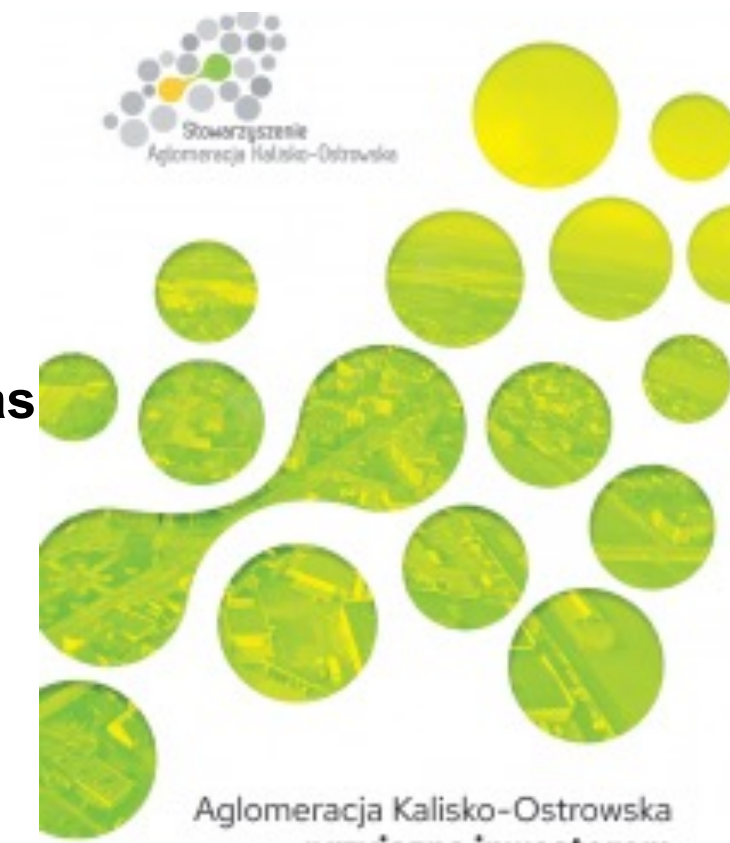

Creating local/regional thematic cooperation networks.



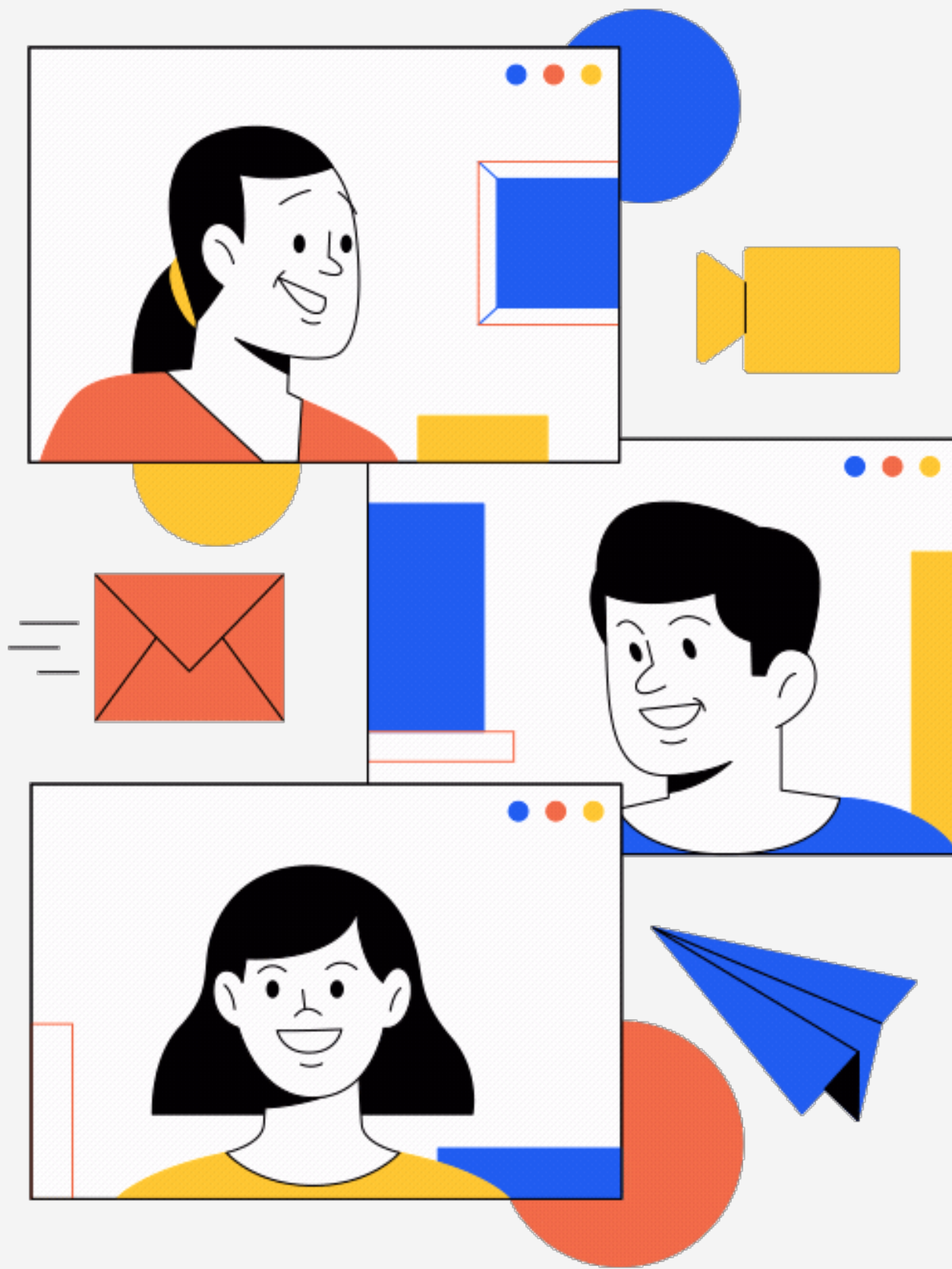
